Patricia Smith Robinson, age 73, passed away peacefully with her family at her side at Tallahassee Memorial Hospital. She surrendered to the complications of Breast Cancer on May 26, 2017.

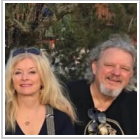

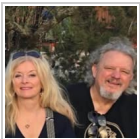
