



## Dr. Paul Siegfried Dasher

September 10, 1934 - October 28, 2017

Dr. Paul Siegfried Dasher, age 83, of Tallahassee, Florida, passed away peacefully on Saturday, October 28, 2017 at home surrounded by his loving family. He was born in Spremburg, Germany to Fritz and Ruth Juliusburger Otto and lived most of his life in the United States.

As an orphan and refugee from Germany following World War II in 1950, Paul was adopted by Lester and Esther Dasher of Toledo, Ohio. He served in the U.S. Army as a Captain at Walter Reed Medical Center in Washington D.C. He is a graduate of the University of Toledo, and the University of Michigan Medical School. Paul had a deep faith, gave his life to Jesus and was a deacon and member of the Coral Ridge Presbyterian Church in Ft. Lauderdale, and upon retirement was a member of Mount Calvary Baptist Church in Banner Elk, NC and attended Wildwood Presbyterian Church while living in Tallahassee. He loved choral and classical music, was a member of several choirs, played golf and tennis, was a pilot, loved to travel and snow ski. Paul touched thousands of lives during his career as an Ear, Nose and Throat surgeon.

He is survived by his wife of 56 years, Linda, daughter Carol Bercaw (Jeff) of Lake Worth, Fl. son, Doug Dasher (Christi) of Pompano Beach, Fl., and son Mike Dasher (Rachel) of Tallahassee, Fl. Paul loved his grandchildren; Joshua, Hannah and Emily Bercaw, Gregg and Jack Dasher as well as Daniel Dasher.
