Ken Weaver, a 31-year resident of Crawfordville, Florida (previously of Miami, Florida) went home to be with his Heavenly Father, on October 15, 2016.

He was the minister for the Washington Street Church of Christ, Quincy, FL for more than 30 years. Ken dedicated his life to serving the Lord and preaching the word in spirit and in truth.

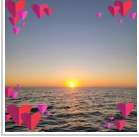
