Peggy Brett Page, 91, of Wakulla Station, died peacefully on June 12, 2024, after a lengthy illness.

Born January 5, 1933, in DeFuniak Springs, the third daughter of John and Gladys Brett, Peggy lived in Tallahassee and graduated from Leon High School in 1950. On June 16, 1956, she married her husband of 48 years Edward L. Page Sr. Peggy retired from Florida State University where she worked for many years. In 1983, she and Ed moved to Wakulla Station where she resided until her passing.

The middle child of seven brothers and sisters Peggy dearly loved and was fiercely loyal to her siblings, her in-laws and her many nieces and nephews.
