Philip Henry Greger Sr., age 95, entered into eternal rest Saturday, November 17, 2018, in Tallahassee, Florida after a brief illness. He was born in New Brunswick, New Jersey on March 15, 1923, enlisted in the US Navy during WWII and completed Seebee training and was sent to Guam for the construction of an airfield in preparation for the invasion of Japan. He received an Honorable Discharge at the wars conclusion and returned to employment for the NJ Bell Telephone Company. After thirty years of dedicated service, he retired to Naples, FL in 1971 and worked for the Collier County Public School System for an additional fourteen years. He was a lifetime member of the Telephone Pioneers of America. He is preceded in death by his wife, Gloria Eggers Greger of 68 years and ten siblings.
