



## Ralph Cecil Ferrell Sr.

July 23, 1941 - January 26, 2017

Ralph Cecil Ferrell, Sr., was an avid outdoorsman who loved to fish and hunt. Just as the trees teach us acceptance when the leaves die in the fall, Ralph Ferrell passed away suddenly at his home in Crawfordville, Florida, on January 26, 2017. Like the old stones that suffer with memory, may we learn renewal like the seeds that rise in the spring. Ralph was born in Hayesville, North Carolina, on July 23, 1941, to the late Clinton Lamar and Hettie (Beal) Ferrell. He spent his early years in Tallahassee, Florida, and graduated from Leon High School in 1960. He joined the Air Force to see the world and was stationed at Eglin Air Force Base! During this time, he married Patricia Ireland from Tallahassee and from this union they had a son, Ralph Cecil Ferrell, Jr. (better known to us as Bo). After his honorable discharge, he returned to Tallahassee, Florida, and began his 35+ year career with the Florida Department of Revenue and retired in 2003. After retirement, his new passion became golf and he enjoyed the beauty and challenge of the game. He also made a Hole in One at the Hilaman Golf Course which was documented by his golfing buddies, Jeff Jansen, Harry Symons, and John Holgan. Ralph is a Past Exalted Ruler of Tallahassee Elks Lodge #937.

He is survived by his wife of 37 years, Julia Montford Ferrell, and three sons: Bo (wife, Brenda, and sons Cody [Shelby] and Dillon and great grandson

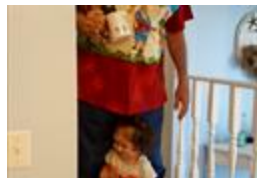
