Phillip "Randall" Prosser of Fort Braden, passed away on Friday, December 13 at the age of 63 years. He was the son of the late Manuel Prosser and Myrtle Exum Prosser. He was born in Quincy, Florida, but lived most of his life in Tallahassee. He was a member of Lake Talquin Baptist Church. A 1967 graduate of Rickards High School, he earned an AA degree from TCC and a Bachelors Degree in Criminology from FSU.

Randall worked for the State of Florida, mostly in juvenile probation and parole work, retiring after 30 years to pursue his love for travel and photography. He also loved hunting and fishing and was the treasurer of the Palmetto Hunting Camp in the Fort Braden Community.
