



## Robert Michael "Mike" Cleary Jr.

Robert Michael "Mike" Cleary, Jr., age 65, of Tallahassee, Florida, died at Tallahassee Memorial HealthCare on April 9, 2024.

Mike was born on January 22, 1959 in Muskogee, Oklahoma to Robert Michael Cleary and Patsy Hardy. He graduated in 1977 from Midwest City High School, where he was a multisport athlete (baseball, basketball, and football).

Mike subsequently pursued a career in the oil business at which time he married Elizabeth "Liz" Santilli on December 28, 1984. Mike and Liz had two sons together and moved to Tallahassee in 1991 to raise their family. Mike owned and operated Elsasser's Lock & Key, a locksmith business serving the greater Tallahassee area, for over 30 years.
