Robert Alan Day 53, of Tallahassee passed away March 30, 2022, after a lengthy illness. He was born on May 20, 1968, in Columbus, Georgia to the late William Jackson Day and Diane Day Brim. Robert spent most of his early years in Florence, Alabama and later moved to Tallahassee, Florida.
