



## Robert Weston "Bob" Hall

January 18, 1927 - March 25, 2021

Robert Weston "Bob" Hall, 94, passed away on March 25, 2021 in Tallahassee. He was born in Jacksonville, Florida to adoptive parents George and Martha Hall on January 18, 1927. Bob was a proud Leon Lion and was a member of the first co-ed graduating class at Florida State University, earning a Bachelors degree. He was a member of their Pi Kappa Alpha "Pike" Fraternity and remained a dedicated member of their Alumni Association until his passing.

Bob joined the Army in 1944 and was honorably discharged as a Sargent after the issuance of President Truman's proclamation that ended World War II. Following his separation from the Army, Bob started a lengthy career in the Telecommunications industry, starting with the original Southern Bell. He went on to earn many titles as it evolved into BellSouth and ATT&T. The role he was most fond of, however, was as marketing manager of Yellow Pages.

Bob was a member of Fellowship Presbyterian Church and later began attending Westminster Presbyterian Church, where he remained a devoted member until present. He was also a long-time member of the Tallahassee Kiwanis Club. He was a history buff - he loved reading about it, talking about it, and was a living example of it. In fact, he attended classes much later in life at his alma mater and received an honorary degree from his continuing studies of Napoleonic Code.

Survivors include his loving children, Trisha Van Petten (Mike) and Clay Hall (Debbie); grandchildren Katharyn Schwalbert (Steven), Weston Van Petten, Andrew Hall (Ally), and William Hall; great-grandchildren Graham Schwalbert and Eli Schwalbert. Bob was preceded in death by his wife Jean Dunning Hall in 2013.
