Mr. Robert McNair Hayman, Jr., of Tallahassee, FL, formerly of Tampa, passed away Monday, November 16th, 2020 at Elmcroft Senior Living in Tallahassee, FL while under the care of Big Bend Hospice. Mr. Hayman was born in Arcadia, FL, on October 21, 1933, son of the late Robert McNair, Sr. and Nellie Grace (McCall) Hayman. He served his country as a member of the Air Force from 1952 to 1956. He was a proud graduate of the University of Florida, obtaining a BS in Business Administration in 1960. He was a former treasurer of the University of Florida Alumni Association. While living in Tampa, FL, he worked as a certified public accountant. After retirement, he moved to Paris, France, where his beloved wife, Carlean, worked for the United States government. After her retirement, they built a home in Quincy, FL, where they lived until her death in March 2012. Robert and Carlean were married on December 20, 1968, in Tampa, FL. There were no children from this union.

Mr. Hayman is survived by his stepdaughter, Lisa (Charles) Hodges; his granddaughter, Tiffany Phillips; and his great-grandson, Killian Phillips - all of Tallahassee, FL; and his sister, Mildred Webster, of Fayetteville, AR. He was preceded in death by his wife, Carlean, his father, and his mother. At his request, there will be no service. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, his ashes will be held by his survivors until travel is safer. His final resting place will be the Martha Washington Cemetery, Clarkrange, TN, where his ashes will be

scattered next to his wife's grave.
