Robert (Bob) Monroe Martin, 81, of Tallahassee, FL, passed away on January 19, 2023.

Robert was born on August 13, 1941, to Robert and Delci Martin in Memphis, TN. After graduating from Christian Brothers High School, where he was a 3-sport letterman, in 1959, he went on to study Business Administration at Memphis State University on a baseball scholarship, graduating in 1964.
