



Reverend Robert Glen Taylor, Jr., D.D.

July 8, 1925 - September 8, 2021

Taylor, Reverend Robert Glen, Jr., D. D., was promoted from his earthly home in Tallahassee, Florida, to his Heavenly home on September 8, 2021. There he was met by his Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, Whom he had faithfully served for many decades. He was called to preach at an early age; after serving three years in the US Navy during World War II, he attended Bob Jones University and Seminary. He pastored Southside Baptist Church in Tallahassee for 46 years and was lovingly known as a true shepherd of his flock. His life was not spent, but invested for the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

He was predeceased by his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Robert G. Taylor, Sr.; his wife of 49 years, Veronica Taylor; his sister, Frances Thomas; and his son-in-law, Jerry Young.
