



## Robert Charles Wilson

December 27, 1947 - February 10, 2018

Robert Charles Wilson died February 10, 2018 in a raceway accident near Savannah, GA.

Robert “Bob” was born 27 December 1947 in St Louis, MO. He was preceded in death by his adoptive parents Sarajane Freeman and Robert Dale Wilson. Bob earned his Bachelor’s Degree at DePauw University, his Master’s Degree at Florida State University, and completed his Doctoral course work at the University of Florida.

He served an enlistment in the U S. Army during the Viet Nam Era, where he worked as a court reporter.

In 2008, Bob retired from the National Park Service, Southeast Archeological Center in Tallahassee. He worked for 25 years as a Supervisory Archeologist and Associate Director of the Center. Bob continued to support the parks and museum resources after his retirement by doing work in many of our National Parks.

Bob is survived by his wife Christa Brown Wilson, Crawfordville, FL; his son and daughter-in-law, Jeffrey Ian and Sarah Kimball Wilson, New Orleans, LA; mother-in-law, Dorothy Brown, Foley, AL; brother-in-law, Skip Brown, Perdido Beach, AL and his close friends Charles and Karen Parker, Riverview, FL, Dennis Finch, Tallahassee, and Thomas Potts, Asheville, NC.
