Roger Earl Outlaw, 66, peacefully passed away on June 25, 2023, in Tallahassee, FL, from complications of a chronic illness. He was surrounded by his family,

Roger was born in Jacksonville to Richard 'Al' and Nannie 'Nan' Outlaw. Roger became an early world traveler at only a few months old when he and his mom accompanied Al to Al's next U.S. Navy duty assignment in Iceland.
