Ronald (Ron) Clarence Braswell passed away on February 7, 2023 at the age of 84. He was born on August 16, 1938 in Jacksonville Florida to Marvin and Faye Braswell. After Graduating from Andrew Jackson High School, he earned an Electrical Engineering Degree at the University of Florida in 1960.
