Ronald David Harrell, 72, of Monticello, FL, passed away Thursday, October 22, 2015 at Tallahassee Memorial Hospital.

They traveled to East Africa and several other countries for many years to support indigenous pastors. Ron was a founding member of Good Samaritan United Methodist Church, where he served as prayer leader. He was a trained prayer minister with Tallahassee Healing Prayer Ministries, Inc.
