Roy McLeod passed away on July 12, 2015 at Shands Hospital in Gainesville, Florida due to complications arising from a burn accident.

Roy was born on the Fourth of July, 1938 and he always believed the nation celebrated just for him. Actually, he was probably taught that by his parents, Edd and Evelyn McLeod.

Roy was raised in Perry, Florida and attended the University of Florida and graduated from Mississippi State. He worked for many years with the State of Florida and retired from the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicle as an ISA Coordinator for the Florida Tax Collectors in 2005. One of the highlights of his life was volunteering at Medart Elementary School as a second and third grade reading teacher. He loved being out and about and hearing a child yell, "Hey Mr. Roy".

Roy is survived by his wife of 31 years, Nina; his daughter, Michele Toomer (Curtis); granddaughter, Whitney Canney (Tim) and grandson, Joshua Toomer. He is preceded in death by his parents Edd & Evelyn McLeod, his son Edd Roy McLeod, III and his step-son, John Kevin Ozbolt.
