Russell Earl Paul, born to Peggy Schipman Paul and Earl Edward Paul, died on January 9, 2019 in Tallahassee with his mother at his side. Russell was 57 years old. Russell was born in Hermosa Beach, California on October 29, 1961. He is survived by his sons Erik and Devin Paul, his granddaughter Corey Paul, his brother Marc Paul, sisters Lorraine Dellorto and Margie Jarvis and his mother. His grandparents were Dan and Theresa Schipman, from Florence S.C. Sgt. Paul served in both the Army and the Air Force with distinction earning the Bronze Star for heroic and meritorious achievement. He was a member of the U.S. Air Force Security Policy Academy in 1982. He attended the Nuclear, Biological and Chemical Defense School in the U.S. Army in 1987. He was the (NCOIC) Training Officer and Narcotics Investigator with the Military Police K-9 Section. Russell also served as the Civil/Court Liaison Officer, Investigator, with the Department of Defense Police in 1991. At one point in his military career, as Senior Airmen in the Air Force, Russell was responsible, as K-9 military police, for guarding the presidential plane Air Force One. Russell was the Police Communications Training Officer with the Tallahassee Police Department (TPD) from July 1991 – April 1998. In more recent years, he was a successful entrepreneur owning a printer company called Paul Products Company. Russell was a graduate of Largo Senior High School in 1979 and the Community College of the Air Force, Maxwell AFB. He was the President of the Wakulla County Babe Ruth Association. Russell lived in Wakulla county for over thirty years. He was a huge fan of Wakulla baseball. In addition to his family, he loved serving in the military and German Shepherds. A memorial gathering and service will be held at the Tallahassee National Cemetery on February 4, at 2 p.m.
