



## Sanna Jane Taylor DeMilly

December 16, 1923 - August 14, 2013

Sanna Jane Taylor DeMilly, daughter of Phil and Willie Taylor, passed away late in the evening of August 14th at Westminister Oaks, where she had happily lived for the last twenty years.

Everyone knew Sanna Jane as a sweet and kind southern lady. Her faith was her strength and carried her through her journey in life. A founding member of Faith Presbyterian Church, she taught Sunday School, served as a Den Mother, and remained active in the Women of the Church.

Sanna Jane attended the Demonstration School in Tallahassee, and was graduated from the Florida State College for Women in 1945. She became one of the first speech pathologists in the Florida School System. She began her teaching career in Alachua County, and after returning to Tallahassee taught English at Leon High and Elizabeth Cobb Jr. High School.

She leaves behind her son Walter DeMilly III, daughter Sanna Kay Davis, son in law Tom Davis, grandchildren Taylor Mitchell (Tift), Thomas Davis (Jordan), and great-granddaughters Wren Mitchell, Audrey and Bayon Davis.
