



Shirley Virginia Wiggins

October 16, 1929 - May 10, 2021

Shirley Virginia Wiggins, 91, of Tallahassee, passed away peacefully, surrounded by her children, in Tallahassee, FL on May 10, 2021. Shirley was born in Live Oak (Suwannee County), FL, to Willie Elmer Spencer and Zell Matella (Mitchell) Spencer, on October 16, 1929.

The family moved several times around the State during the Great Depression, living where her father could find work as a butcher. In 1940 Shirley moved to Tallahassee with her mother and sister. Shirley had many fond memories of summers spent on her grandparents' farm in Live Oak, FL. On April 26, 1953, Shirley married Clyde G. Wiggins Jr., at First Baptist Church in Tallahassee. They were married 61 years until his death in 2014. In 1961, Shirley and Clyde joined John Wesley United Methodist Church, where they remained lifetime members.

Shirley is survived by four children, Janet Combs (Robert), Lisa Dove (Jep), Clyde G. Wiggins III (Debbie), and Mary Andrews (Rob); six grandchildren, Ray McClellan, Chad McClellan, Sarah Andrews, Dylan Andrews, Holly Wiggins, and Brittany Wiggins. She was predeceased by her parents, her husband, Clyde G. Wiggins Jr., and her sister, Patricia Green, of Perry, GA. Mama would always tell us that she ended every day with a prayer for each family member, starting with our father and going down the list.
