Stephanie Lunder Warren, 49, passed away peacefully at her Tallahassee home on August 7, 2017, surrounded by those who loved her. Ms. Warren, a daughter of former Tallahassee residents Jan Tanenbaum and Joanne Tanenbaum, was a graduate of Smith College, where she majored in French and minored in art history. She received a masters degree in French from New York University.

Born and raised in Tallahassee, Ms. Warren lived in New York City for over twenty years before returning more recently to Tallahassee. During her time in New York, she was active in a number of political campaigns, charities, and volunteer groups, including the New York Junior League. In recent years, Ms. Warren developed a passion for the law. She fought for and achieved significant progress towards justice and improved mental health care for vulnerable adults.

An accomplished flutist and later board member of the Tallahassee Symphony Orchestra, Ms. Warren loved music, art, the law, and fashion. In Tallahassee, she could often be found out in the yard gardening or walking her beloved miniature schnauzer Minerva. No matter how ill she felt, she never forgot someone's birthday or their important life event. Stephanie had a knack for matchmaking, and relished in the happiness she brought others through her matches.

Stephanie will be remembered for her many unique talents, including her wittiness, her sharp mind, her one-of-a-kind sense of humor and her ability to make anyone laugh, her boundless energy and vivacious personality, her fabulous sense of style, her creative flair, her storytelling abilities, and her fighting spirit.

Ms. Warren showed tremendous bravery while facing obstacles that stretched even beyond her physical illness in recent years. Her strength, positivity, determination and courage inspired all those around her, and will never be forgotten.

Ms. Warren was predeceased by her grandparents, former Tallahassee residents Dr.

Lewis Tanenbaum and Mrs. Gertrude Lunder Tanenbaum, as well as by her grandparents Mr. Sidney DeLove and Mrs. Claire DeLove. She is survived by many friends and family who will miss her dearly and cherish their memories of her.
