



## Dr. Surendar Singh Lamba

March 3, 1934 - September 17, 2016

Dr. Surendar S. Lamba, 82, of Tallahassee, passed away September 17, 2016 at the Margaret Z. Dozier Hospice House at Big Bend Hospice. He was preceded in death by his wife of 33 years, Betty Lamba.

A memorial service will be held at 7:00 P.M., Wednesday, September 21st at New Hope Christian Center, 2725 Florida-Georgia Highway, Havana, Florida. In lieu of flowers, gifts in memory of Dr. Lamba may be made to Big Bend Hospice, 1723 Mahan Center Blvd., Tallahassee, FL 32308.

Born March 3, 1934 in Dehra Dun, India, he moved to the United States in 1959 to further his education. He was a graduate of the University of Nebraska and received his Ph.D. in Pharmacy and Medicinal Chemistry from the University of Colorado.

Dr. Lamba came to Tallahassee in 1965 as a Professor of Pharmacy at Florida A&M University's College of Pharmacy, and devoted 37 years to the pharmacy program, retiring in 2003 as Professor Emeritus.

Survivors include his son and daughter-in-law, Jay and Ronda Lamba of Tallahassee; and two grandsons, Collin and Connor Lamba.
