Suzanne Dann Baham, 73, died at her beloved lifelong home on May 3, 2024 with her daughter by her side.

Born on August 9, 1950 and raised in Tallahassee by her loving parents, Thomas Bernard Dann and Edith Corinne Hamrick Dann, Suzanne graduated from Leon High School in 1968, attended Huntingdon College, and earned a Bachelor's in Special Education from the University of Southern Louisiana. She chose to be a stay-at-home mother, providing a variety of educationally enriching experiences and opportunities to her daughter. Throughout Suzanne's life, she volunteered in numerous organizations, including Special Olympics, Girl Scouts, Leon County Schools, Youth for Understanding, and her neighborhood association.

She was an avid fan of FSU sports and worked for many years in the FSU Athletics Ticket Office.

Suzanne was known and admired for her steely strength, determination, strong work ethic, tenaciousness, and many artistic talents, including oil painting, stained glass, quilting, crocheting, and sewing. Most recently, she loved working in her garden.

She was a no-nonsense, steadfast friend. Above all, she was a fiercely

devoted, loving mother and grandmother (Nonna) who cherished every moment with her family, doted on her grandson, and instilled her love of dogs and cats in them.

She is survived by her daughter Catherine Ann Carson, grandson Alexander Thomas Baham, and son-in-law Christopher Royal Carson. She was preceded in death by her parents.
