July 5, 1929 - January 23, 2017

Talmadge Onzelo Harrison, age 87, entered into rest January 23, 2017. Talmadge was born in Grady County, GA, and was a lifelong resident of Tallahassee. He was a graduate of Leon High School and Florida State University. Talmadge was a U.S. Army Veteran, a former member of The Rock United Methodist Church, current member of Chaires United Methodist Church and a former board member of the First Commerce Credit Union. Talmadge was retired from the State of Florida, Department of Labor-Unemployment Insurance where he served as Assistant Director. He was also a former employee of the Tallahassee Police Department. Talmadge was preceded in death by his son, Rex Onzelo Harrison, two sisters and one brother. Survivors include his wife of sixty years, Bobbie M. 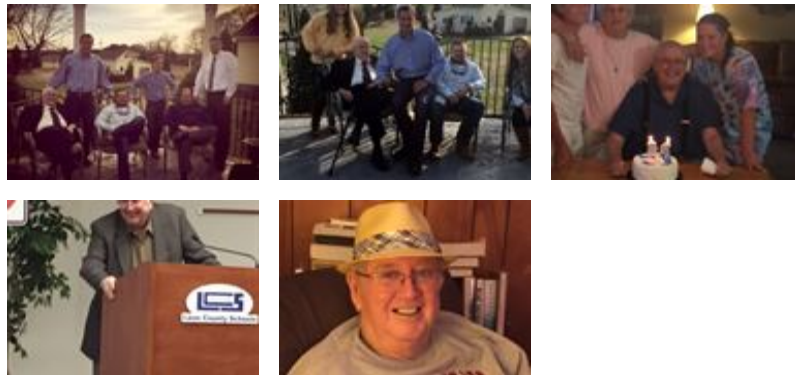
