



## Theresa Eileen Hollar

October 8, 1935 - July 29, 2023

Our loving and kind mother, Theresa Eileen Hollar, 87, of Tallahassee, Florida died on July 29, 2023 after a second fight with cancer.

She was born in Sidney, MT on October 8, 1935. She grew up working hard on a farm in Trotters, ND and attended college in Dickinson, ND completing a teaching degree. On August 19, 1955 Theresa married William Wayne Hollar. Together they had four children. Their life's journey together brought them to Beach, ND, Billings, MT, Preston, MN, Rochester, MN, Albuquerque, NM, Pine Island, MN, and Tallahassee, FL. She enjoyed every minute she had with family and friends. She was never without a hobby she enjoyed. At various times in her life, she

enjoyed golfing, bowling, playing cards with friends, sewing, quilting, doing crafts, serving her church, going out for dinner (particularly to the Wharf with friends), and especially tending to her flower gardens. She was in her garden pulling the ever growing weeds every day she could.

Theresa was preceded in death by her parents Norman and Ruth Nellerroe, her husband of 58 years William Wayne Hollar, her granddaughter Ashley Ann Hollar, her sister Burneal Marie Nellerroe Albin, her brother John Orville Nellerroe, and three brother-in-laws and one sister-in-law. She is survived by her four children Patricia Eileen Frohlich (Terry), William Henry Hollar (Lisa), Robert Harold Hollar (Suzanne), Nancy Kay Lefort (Mark), 9 grandchildren, 10 great-grandchildren, 1 great-great grandson, 3 sisters and 1 brother.
