



Thomas Richard Daniels

February 1, 1943 - July 24, 2020

Thomas Richard Daniels, age 77, entered rest July 24, 2020, after a courageous battle with Parkinson's Disease. He was born in Chicago, IL and had lived in Tallahassee since 1980. Tom was a senior computer engineering specialist in the U.S. Air Force, and while stationed in Maine at Topsham Air Force Station, met Cecile Cormier, his future wife of 54 years. After his military service, he worked as a Senior Field Engineer for 30 years with IBM, and then began a 15-year second career with Florida DEP. Tom was a member of Good Shepherd Catholic Church, sang in the Parkinson's Choir, and as a Ham Radio Operator (W1EOH), was a lifetime member of ARRL. Survivors include his wife Cecile; daughters Karen (Jason) Hickey, Susan (Matt) Horan, 4 grandchildren Jenna and Ashley Horan, Anna and Eli Hickey; brothers Ken (Marilyn) Daniels, Andy (Tina) Daniels.
