Thomas Subers Maxwell, 88, of Tallahassee, passed away Friday, October 21, 2011 in Dothan, Alabama. He was preceded in death on October 25, 2009 by his wife, Hazel Maxwell.

The funeral service will be held at 2:00 PM, EDT, Tuesday, October 25, 2011 at Fellowship Baptist Church, 3705 North Monroe Street in Tallahassee.
