Thomas (Tom) Leonard Wade III, age 76, beloved husband, father and grandfather, passed away at home on Thursday evening, August 24, 2017. Tom, born in Tuscaloosa, Alabama, was a lifelong resident of Tallahassee, FL. After graduating from Leon High School, Tom served in the Marine Corps Reserve and the Coast Guard Reserve, retiring from military service after 43 years with the rank of Captain.
