Mr. Thomas (Tommy) H. McAnally, 76, of Carrabelle FL passed away Sunday December 23, 2018 at Tallahassee Memorial Hospital in Tallahassee, FL. Tommy McAnally was born in 1942. He was a native of Carrabelle, FL. He served 20 years in the Air Force and retired as Master Sergeant. While in the military, he received Air Force Commendation Medal, Air Force Good Conduct Medal with four Oak Leaf Clusters, Small Arms Expert Marksmanship Ribbon, Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal, Air Longevity Service Ribbon with four Oak Leaf Clusters, National Defense Service Medal, Vietnam Service Medal, and Air Force Outstanding Unit Award with one Oak Leaf Cluster. After retiring from the military he was a postal clerk for Carrabelle and Lanark Village. He was an active member of the American Legion Post 82 in Lanark Village for many years and was a member of Carrabelle United Methodist Church. Tommy is survived by his wife Evelyn I.
