



## Veto Nicholas Paritte

May 29, 1923 - March 19, 2016

Veto was born on May 29, 1923 in Franklin Township, New Jersey. He was the son of Neva and Jack Paritte. Veto Joined the Navy in 1942 at the age of 17 and served with Honor in the European Front as a Pharmacists Mate Second Class on LST URL 39.

On D-Day while landing on Normandy Beach he was wounded by shrapnel. After receiving medical treatment for his injuries Veto served with a recon team in France locating a suitable place for a field hospital where he continued providing aid to the wounded.

After his discharge in 1945 he worked at American Cyanamid in addition to attending Rutgers University. Veto then began working in the trucking industry and was promoted to a National Accounts Sales Manager position for Lee Way Motor Freight where he was also a member of Delta Nu Alpha Transportation Fraternity. He retired in 1995. After his retirement he did Consulting work for Churchill Trucking Co. Veto was an accomplished Artist.

He is predeceased by his wife Nicholena Paritte. Veto leaves his companion of twenty years Rosemary Weber. He has two children, a daughter Patrice Paritte, and a son Jack Paritte, three grandchildren and two great grandchildren.
