



## Wayne Edward Morgan Sr.

February 17, 1936 - March 3, 2015

Wayne Edward Morgan Sr., born on February 17, 1936 in Hamilton, Ontario, died on March 3, 2015. He was a Crawfordville resident for 43 years.

In 1962, he was initiated into the Pipeliner's Local Union 798. While serving in the Union he was appointed to the finance committee on December 9, 1977, then elected to the position of President from April 13, 1979- January 7, 1999, and was also elected as a United Association(UA) Delegate to attend the UA Convention in 1981, 1986, 1991 and 1996. Wayne was a Master Mason in the Crawford Loge 294, a member of the Scottish Rite, Marzuq Shriners, American Welding Society, where he was a Certified Welding Inspector and held a Master Plumbers license for over 50 years. Wayne traveled extensively across the US and abroad as a Union Pipeline welder. One of his most notable accomplishments was working on the Alyeska Pipeline in Alaska, one of the United States' biggest projects. He worked for several contractors for approximately 5 years helping assemble over 750 miles of pipe.

Wayne is survived by his wife of 56 years, Kathy Morgan; brother, Russ Hillier (Pam); three sons, Tom Morgan (Peggy), Wayne Morgan Jr. and Rick Morgan; eight grandchildren, JD Morgan, Jon Morgan , Jason Owens, Amber Morgan, Dylan Morgan, Rusty Morgan, James Morgan, Sierra Daughtery; ten great grandchildren, Evan, Camdyn, Alexis, Adrianna, Keylee, Chesley, Branson, Nicole, Issac and Lilly.

He is predeceased by his parents, Harold and Eileen Morgan; two sons, Danny Morgan, Jimmy "Jimbo" Morgan and one grandson, Tyler Morgan.

The family will receive friends on Friday, March 6, 2015 from 4:00 PM - 7:00 PM at Bevis Funeral Home, Harvey-Young Chapel in Crawfordville. Funeral Mass will be held on Saturday, March 7, 2015 a 1:00 pm at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Church in Crawfordville with burial immediately following at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Cemetery.

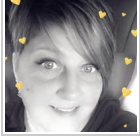

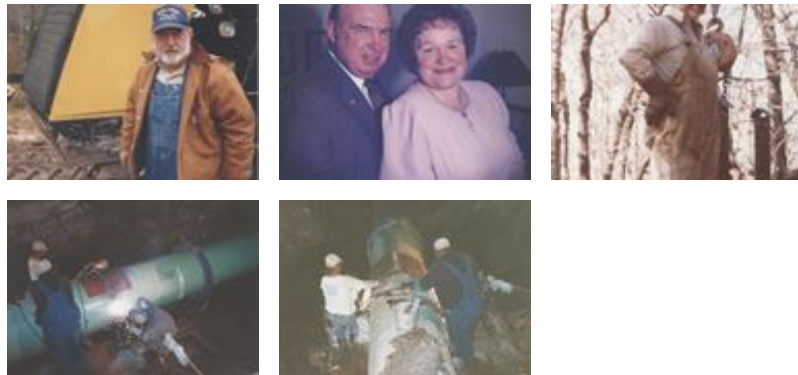
