William Welsh Boyd, 91, of Tallahassee entered into eternal rest on October 21st, 2015. He was born February 20th, 1924 in Blytheville, Arkansas to the late Meno Kent Welsh Boyd and Colonel K.J. Boyd. He was predeceased by his only sibling, Patricia Boyd Ward McLain.

Mr. Boyd studied at the University of Florida until the outbreak of WWII, when he enlisted in the United States Army and served his country in the Pacific Theater. Following the war, he completed his education at North Texas University and worked as an engineer in Ft. Worth, TX before returning to Tallahassee.

He was politically active throughout his life, a longtime member of the Capital City Republican Club and the Round Table. "Uncle Bill", beloved family patriarch, is survived by his devoted niece, Laura Jernigan; his grandnieces, Amelia (Christopher) Shupe and Catherine (Nicholas) Voran; and his five great-grandnieces and nephews, Genevieve, William, Alyssa, Alex and Sophia.
