William Rowell Ingram, Jr. or known to many as “Wild Bill”, passed away on February 18, 2018, in Tallahassee, Florida at the age of 67.

He was born in Miami, Florida to William Rowell Ingram and Lena Blanche Ingram on July 28, 1950. He married Jean Hay Ingram on June 26, 1976 in Thomasville, Georgia.

Bill graduated from Florida State University with a B.S. degree in Marketing and from Asbury Theological Seminary with a Master of Divinity and had the pleasure of serving as the Pastor of Calvary, Centennial and Bethel United Methodist Churches located in South Georgia. Additionally, Bill had the honor of being the Pastor of Grace United Methodist Church (Hosford, FL) and Chaires United Methodist Church in Tallahassee, FL where he retired in 2010. Bill enjoyed life to the fullest and participated in the Kairos Prison Ministry, the Big Bend Walk to Emmaus, the Parkinson’s Outreach Association and the Christian Motorcycle Association.

Bill is survived by his parents Bill and Blanche Ingram, his wife Jean Ingram, his three children Will Ingram, Maggie (Will) Mickler, and Matthew Ingram, and his sister Janie (Duey) Blackwell. He is preceded in death by his sister Nancy Ingram.

A memorial service will be held at 11:00 a.m. Saturday, February 24 at Chaires United Methodist Church.
