The family later moved to Tallahassee FL where Eddie attended Leon High School (1968) and soon graduated from FSU School of Criminology. He was hired by the Alachua County Sheriff's Office and retired 26 years later in 2002, during which time he rose through the ranks and served in several areas of the agency. A year after retirement he chose to work one year for the Department of Defense as a civilian police advisor in Iraq.

His fun times consisted of "running the roads doing errands," loving on his dog, Deacon, keeping his wife, Julie of 38 years on her toes with his antics, being a doting dad to his daughter, Jayme Stanton (Steve) and spending guy time with his son, Jeffrey. In addition to immediate family, Eddie is survived by his niece, Kelly Tilton and nephew Gene Whitworth, Brian Hood (Paulina) and Katie Hood, their children as well as numerous relatives in Gainesville, FL and

North Carolina.

Eddie passed peacefully while under the care of Hospice House staff and well taken care of by incredible in-home care in the weeks prior. So many neighbors and friends to thank for all that they have done during this difficult time and special thanks to the immediate family.
