William “Bill” Pericles Miller, MD, 57 passed away on Tuesday, November 12th at Tallahassee Memorial Hospital.

Funeral Services will be held 4:00 Thursday, November 21st at St Peters Anglican Church with Father Michael Petty officiating. Remembrance to follow after service in the Parish Hall. Arrangements are by Bevis Funeral Home.

Bill was born in Memphis, Tennessee to Joseph Calvin Miller, O.D (now deceased) and Elaine Walter Miller. He graduated from Eustis High School where he was also the youngest EMT in Lake County. Bill went on to Alachua Community College, the Florida State PIMS Program, continuing to Medical School at the University of Florida. After his time at the Tallahassee Memorial Residency Program, Bill went to work for Tallahassee Community Hospital in Emergency Medicine, eventually moving to Tallahassee Memorial Emergency Department where he has worked for nearly the last 25 years. He was boarded in both Family and Emergency Medicine.

Bill was married to Cynara Byrd Miller on October 26th, 1991, and they had recently celebrated their 28th anniversary. He is also survived by his 2 loving daughters, Lane Elizabeth Miller, 24, who is currently pursuing a Master’s in Library Science at Florida State University, and Paris Bright Miller, an Honors sophomore and Business major at the University of Florida.

He is also survived by 2 brothers, Michael Aaron Miller, DDC, Joseph Douglas Miller, DDC, as well as his sister Shelle Lea Miller Becker, RN, and Grandfather William Walter. He is survived by a wealth of nieces and nephews, including but not limited to the following: Stephanie, Kayla, Adyson, Morgan, Madilynne, Austin, and James.

Bill was a deeply beloved father and husband. Nothing in the world was more important to him than his Lord and his family.
