William Eppes Proctor, 22, of Tallahassee, Florida, passed away unexpectedly on Sunday, December 6th, 2020. A senior at Florida State University, Will was an amazing young man with a truly bright future.

Will was born September 2, 1998, at Ft. Stewart, GA to Rob and Lesley Proctor. From an early age, Will had a zest for life, adventure, and family, and in 2001, he became a proud brother to Grace. Moving back and forth across the country as Army brats, often without their father who was deployed overseas, Will cultivated a special relationship with his sister. Always on the go, he remained active in sports, school and community events, and spending time with his friends and family.

Will graduated with honors from Newsome High School in Lithia, FL in 2017. While at Newsome, he was involved in many clubs and activities including President of Newsome's Student Government Association, captain of the Football and Track teams, and a member of the National Honor Society.

Attending his dream school, Will was pursuing a Bachelor of Science in Risk Management/Insurance, expected to graduate in the spring of 2021. Will was a proud member and brother of Sigma Phi Epsilon and served as Vice President of Recruitment. He served on the Board of Trustees and as a student leader for the FSU Student Foundation, and as a loyal member of

Seminole Student Boosters. This fall, as a result of his demonstrated service, leadership, and loyalty, he was selected for the prestigious FSU Garnet and Gold Key leadership honor society.

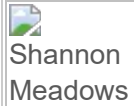
