



## William Truett Shelton

July 22, 1930 - July 30, 2011

Captain William Truett Shelton, 81, of Tallahassee, died Saturday, July 30, 2011 in Tallahassee.

Captain Shelton was a native of Quitaque, Texas and had been a resident of Tallahassee since here from Gainesville, Florida in 1988. A veteran of the United States Air Force, he was retired as a commercial airline pilot. During his career he flew for National Air Lines, Air South, Air Florida, Mackey International Air Lines and Air Puerto Rico. Following his retirement from the air line industry he operated the Pepperidge Farm distributorship in Tallahassee, before spending 12 years with Publix Super Markets.

He is survived by two sons, Shannon Shelton (Janice) of Tallahassee and Stirling Shelton (Julia) of Cincinnati, Ohio; two sisters, Jimmie Marshall of Houston, TX and Ila Rae Veselka of Lavernia, TX; two grandchildren, Jessica Topoleski and Stephanie Gagnon, both of Tallahassee; one great-grandchild, Austin Gagnon, also of Tallahassee; and trusted friend Sally.
