William "Delmar" Smith, 97, passed away on Friday, November 23, 2012 in Tallahassee. He is survived by his wife of 8 years, Dorothy Sanders Smith. Delmar was born and raised in Ochlocknee, Georgia and graduated from Barber School in Jacksonville, Florida. He then settled in Tallahassee where he was a barber for 77 years. He had most recently been attending Capital City Christian Church.
