William Robert "Rob" Warmack, 57, passed away on Thursday, May 4, 2023, surrounded by his wife and two daughters. Rob was born October 29, 1965, in Tallahassee, Florida, to the late Roy R. "Buster" Warmack, Jr., and Joan Quick Warmack. He attended Lincoln High School. After graduating in 1983, he went on to attend Florida Agricultural & Mechanical School on a baseball scholarship.
