Wilmer Lavhon Miles, 76, of Bristol lost his battle with cancer Tuesday, Sept. 11th, 2012, at his home. He was born Sept. 7th, 1936 in Doerun, Ga., but lived most of his life in Gadsden and Liberty Counties. He enlisted in the United States Marine Corps in January 1954 and was proud to have served his country. Upon leaving the Marines he went to work driving for Higdon Grocery Company before eventually starting his own interstate trucking company. After retiring from trucking he worked as a landlord on properties he and his wife had acquired over the years. He enjoyed fishing, family gatherings, and traveling. He was a long standing member of the American Legion, Veterans of Foreign Wars, and The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints.
