



Yung Ja Napier (nee Kim)

August 10, 1933 - October 25, 2017

Yung Ja Napier (nee Kim), age 84, of Tallahassee, passed away on October 25, 2017 after a year's struggle with lung cancer.

Born in Seoul, Korea and a graduate of Ewha Women's University, Yung Ja had endured the Japanese occupation of Korea, as well as World War II, and the Korean War. Soon after, she met her husband and veteran, John W. Napier, Jr., and moved to the United States (Florida), becoming a naturalized American citizen in 1963. The two were longtime residents of Park Forest, Illinois, where Yung Ja supervised the transcription department of the nearby Suburban Heights Medical Center, and of Akron, Ohio, where they moved to be closer to their grandchildren.

Yung Ja is survived by two daughters, Grace Napier (William Monnen) and Alice Pomidor (Bill), and her grandchildren Ben, Gwen, Daniel, and Christina. She was preceded in death by her husband John, as well as her parents, brother, and sister in Korea.

Visitation will be held on Friday, November 17, 2017 from 5 to 7 p.m at Bevis Funeral Home, 200 John Knox Road, Tallahassee. The funeral service will be

held on Saturday, November 18, 2017, at 2 p.m. in the same location. Yung Ja will be buried beside her husband at Tallahassee Memory Garden. Flowers may be sent to Bevis.
